Is God in Math? A Classical Approach

Colossians 1:16: For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones, powers, rulers or authorities: all things were created by and for him.

Math is fundamental in all life skills from cooking, to building, medicine, and time to name just a few concepts. Here at Zion, we teach math not only as numbers, facts, days of the week, but also a part of God's plan to bring organization out of chaos. Math not only helps us to relate to God by implementing logic and order in everyday lives, but also to see His loving plan for our lives the universe, and His truth.

Now more than ever we need to emphasize the truth in math as today's culture tries to dismantle it's (math) truths and in turn add chaos to organization.

We use Biblical principles to lay a solid math foundation at Zion.

We teach students how to properly apply and master elementary math skills in their lives to help them and to help serve others through future careers. We can see this as students learning to follow a recipe when cooking, using fractions while measuring. We know what happens in cooking when you add too much salt to cookies, it's not good! Students also demonstrate Math while designing and putting together school projects. To design and build a building without knowing much about math, physics and nature, we know the result! Thats right Chaos! We also demonstrate God's beauty in creation through Math and Art where students learn about the beauty of symmetry and proportion in art through viewing nature and studying the face and how God's master designs are designed mathematically to be pleasant and peaceful to us and to honor Him.

We also teach students to begin and gain critical thinking skills through Algebra and Geometry. Looking at and solving abstract problems, that are "visible and Invisible" and relating that to life experiences around them.

We demonstrate the "why" and not just the "what" of math, by using manipulatives, songs and experiences to make math more concrete. You can help at home by cooking, taking nature walks and pointing out the symmetry and beauty of plants and flowers, or at a museum look at the beauty of faces and still life pieces. Math helps students to glorify God by utilizing the skills to be a good steward, employee, and productive citizen.

As parents and educators, we want to make sure we educate our students from a Biblical world view. Math along with all subjects help to point to God and his infinite wisdom and plan.


