#### **Classical Corner:**

The first of the four cardinal virtues we will consider is that of justice. Justice finds its roots in truth and goodness, and in the correct balance between selflessness and selfishness, or in other words, having the right amount of one's fair share. Aristotle states, "Justice consists in a certain equality by which the just and definite claim of another, neither more nor less, is satisfied." A modern misuse of this virtue is that of "social justice" movements, which replace the Good News of Christ crucified and risen for the forgiveness of sins with an idea of the betterment of modern society based on the current cultural conception as salvation. According to Scripture, a just man is one who has been declared just and righteous through faith in Jesus Christ and His perfectly holy life and death and who seeks to live in accordance with God's law. A classical Lutheran school seeks to teach and equip children to correctly know right from wrong as defined by Holy Scripture, justice from injustice, and to be assured in faith that God's justice and mercy find their answer in the person and work of Jesus Christ. As such, we seek to assist parents to instill in children faith and a godly quality which inclines each person to work for the good of others with Christian love and grace.

#### From the Headmaster:

Here at Zion we try to teach your children wisdom. The Bible teaches, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of all wisdom." In other words, you cannot have wisdom unless you fear God!

But if fear of God brings wisdom, does that mean that those who don't fear God don't have wisdom? It seems like everyone has at least a little wisdom. Many who do not fear God know how to fix their cars, get promoted, write books, and generally live well. How can fear of the Lord be the beginning of ALL wisdom? Wouldn't it make more sense if the fear of the Lord is the beginning of SOME wisdom? The Bible says "no."

To fear God means to fear his punishment for breaking his law. And when we fear God we receive eternal life. Mary, the mother of Jesus, wrote, "His mercy is on those who fear Him from generation to generation." God has mercy on those who fear him. That is why it is the beginning of ALL wisdom. King Solomon confirms this in Proverbs 14:27 saying "The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, that one may turn away from the snares of death." Fear of the Lord brings eternal life!

Wisdom about your job, house, car, or life only lasts a lifetime if you don't fear God. This temporary "wisdom" apart from fearing God is pointless. But if you fear the Lord, your temporary wisdom lasts forever. It gives your wisdom about your car, your family, your job, and your life meaning. It is our goal here that your children have true wisdom and that the things they do in this life will last forever. This is why we have been teaching the 10 commandments here at school. It teaches your children to fear God's punishment of wrongdo-ing and gives them wisdom unto eternal life! Ask your child to recite commandments 1-5 this week. Then talk with them about God's law and punishment of breaking his law, encouraging them to fear the Lord. Peace be with you this upcoming week.


