On the Importance of Disciplining Children

In today's culture, discipline is not very popular. Discipline often involves punishment, but is better defined as training. We train students to obey authority, have self-control, and desire to do good.

Many schools do not discipline well. Here at Zion, we go to the Bible, God's Word, to learn about disciplining children. Most of the comments are directed toward parents, but we can apply these verses to school discipline as well. Notice the following passages are not popular views of discipline, but they teach what is good for our children. Read through these proverbs and notice what they say about discipline. I added some of my own comments for consideration.

Proverbs 13:24 Whoever spares the rod hates his son, but he who loves him is diligent to discipline him. Comment: Many today look at discipline and fair punishment as hurting their child, but discipline is actually love! If your children do not like your discipline, endure their dislike for a while, because it will be much better for them later on, and they will thank you for it.

Proverbs 22:15 Folly is bound up in the heart of a child, but the rod of discipline drives it far from him. Comment: All kids are foolish, but have potential for wisdom. We often give our kids the benefit of the doubt and think that our kids are wise and mature but the Bible is not so confident. But there is hope. Firm discipline drives their foolishness away!

Proverbs 29:15 The rod and reproof give wisdom, but a child left to himself brings shame to his mother. Comment: Have you ever seen a child in a grocery store throwing a fit and his parents let it continue without discipline? This happens often. Parents are often concerned about the shame of disciplining a child in public, so they avoid it. But this proverb teaches us that the shame of not disciplining a child is worse and God is proud of our discipline!

Proverbs 29:17 Discipline your son, and he will give you rest; he will give delight to your heart. Comment: Is it possible to find rest with children? Actually yes, through discipline. Discipline not only benefits our children, it also benefits us. When we discipline our children, it will give us rest and delight.

We at Zion seek to discipline our students because we love them, and we want them to grow up wise. As we discipline fairly, we train them to be fair towards others and respectful toward their parents. This will help them live better lives here on earth!

- ◆ Idaho Parental Choice Tax Credit Program bill There is a hearing this coming Tuesday, March 12th, at the Capitol at 9am. If this program passes, it makes Idaho families eligible for a refundable tax credit worth up to \$5,000. The tax credit can cover the cost of private school tuition and fees. I encourage anyone to attend the meeting to show support and give in person testimony about the importance of this bill. Remote testimony can be made as well. Fine Print: You may not refer yourself. The new student must enroll and attend Zion Lutheran School for at least three (3) full months. Their registration, tuition and all applicable fees must be current. The referral payment will be credited to your account or given to you as a check if your account is paid in full. There is no limit to the number of students that you can refer. Referral payments can be split if more that one person is listed as the referral for the same student.
