- Zion Lutheran Church End of Summer Community BBQ: Saturday, August 16th, from Noon - 4:00 pm.

- **Zion Lutheran School First Day of School:** Monday, August 25th, is the first day of school for all students 5 Day and Bridge Program -
 - **Bridge Students** will have classes Monday 8-25, Tuesday 8-26, and Thursday 8-28 for the first week of school.
 - **Chapel Uniform:** For all students, for the first week of school only, the uniform will be the Chapel White Uniform on both Monday, (8-25) and Thursday, (8-28).
 - **Weekly Uniforms:** The ZLS Uniform on Monday (after the 1st week of school), Tuesday, and Wednesday, and the Zion Spirit shirts on Fridays, or other designated days by the Headmaster.
- Zion Lutheran School Pick up and Drop Times and Procedures:
 - **Drop Off:** 07:30 am to 7:55 am. PK 3rd graders must be walked into the school by their parents. 4th 9th graders may walk in by themselves.
 - 8:00 am or after is considered Tardy. * Having your child at school by 7:55 am, allows teachers to take attendance & lunch count before services start at 8:00 am.
 - All morning Matins and Chapel Services start at 8:00 am.
 - Pickup: School ends for all grades at 3:00 pm.
 - **PK 3rd graders** must be picked up by their parents or pickup designated adult by 3:10 pm in the school.
 - 4th 9th graders can be released by their home room teachers and picked up by their parents or designated adult pickup person at the exterior classroom doors by 3:10 pm.
 - Any student not picked up by 3:10 pm, will go to After School Care.

NUNTIUS - ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- ZLS After School Care: All school days from 3:00 to 6:00 pm in the Kindergarten Classroom.
 - The front door is locked at 3:15 pm, unless there is a special school event.
 - If you arrive to pickup your child at or after 3:15 pm, you will not be able to come through the front door. Please pull up to the farthest eastern door on the parking lot side (Door 203) and call the ASC #s posted on the door.

- Call the numbers, and the ASC Staff will bring your child to the designated door for ASC pickup and you will have you sign them out. Please be patient, and know that during the first couple of weeks, with all our new families, they may ask to see a picture ID to correspond with the name on the ASC Form, that you turned in during enrollment.
- All After School Care parents are charged for the first hour (3:00 pm to 4:00 pm) regardless if they pick up their child before 4:00 pm After the first hour; however, we bill in 30 minute increments. If you use this program, watch for monthly bills via FACTS Tuition Management under incidentals. You have 30 days to pay after the charges are applied to your account, or the account becomes delinquent. Your account must be current to ensure on-going participation.
- If you have any immediate concerns with the ASC program, please contact our Lead ASC Staff member, Mrs. Rippy at (208) 724-2537 or our Headmaster, Mr. Joshua Swigart at (541) 971-9492. Any non emergencies can be addressed to the same staff members in the morning during the next school day.



MEET DR. MARTIN ZUMMERSCH!

We would like to say a heartfelt welcome to Dr. Martin Zummersch! Dr. Martin Zummersch was born in 1965 in Oelde, Germany, a small farming and manufacturing town first mentioned over 1,200 years ago. The first in his family to graduate high school, attend college, and move abroad, he has embraced a life of learning, exploration, and service. His mother and entire family still live in the small town close to Muenster, (and for the historical buffs) where the peace treaty ending the 30 year war was signed. Church and Faith have always played a key role in this daily life. He attended Catholic Churches since the age of 7, volunteered in Catholic youth organizations, and became a Lutheran Missouri Synod in 2009.



Dr. Zummersch & Son Sebastian

After completing high school in Beckum, Germany in 1986, Dr. Zummersch served in the German Airforce before earning degrees in Mechanical Engineering (1990) and Marketing (1992) in Germany. He later moved to the United States in 1995, where he earned an MBA in Operations Management and a Doctorate in Management from Case Western Reserve University, researching group decision-making and innovation. Dr. Zummersch has worked and lived across three continents—including Germany, the Netherlands, Belgium, China, and the U.S.—and traveled to over 40 countries. A U.S. citizen since 2019 (2 weeks before he moved to Boise), he continues to pursue his passion for teaching and mentoring, serving for over 15 years as an adjunct faculty member at various U.S. universities. Grounded in his faith, Dr. Zummersch has been actively involved in church and community life since childhood. A longtime volunteer—from youth organizations in Germany to inner-city programs in Cleveland— he currently supports other local initiatives such as the farmers Market in Meridian. Dr. Zummersch is also member of the Project Management Institute PMI, and the American Society for Quality ASQ, where he is on the board of the Boise Chapter.

Dr Zummersch is a proud father of Sebastian, who just turned 14. Sebastian was confirmed at Zion Lutheran Church in Nampa in 2023. He went to New Orleans as part of the youth group and absolutely loved it. Sebastian attended Zion Lutheran School in Nampa and is starting High School at Cole Valley. The 3rd family member is Luke, our German Short Hair Pointer. Hence the energy level at the Zummersch household is very high.

Dr. Zummersch is not a stranger to Zion Lutheran School. He was a Zion Parent while Sebastian attended and has been supporting the Zion Lutheran School's Chess Club for over 4 years. He is looking forward to teaching at Zion Lutheran School as the 5th and 6th grade Home Room Teacher, and Teaching Science and Math to the 5th - 9th graders.
