From the Headmaster

Overview on the ZLS Parent Survey Responses:

About half of ZLS parents (12) filled out the ZLS parent survey sent out in November. The feedback was very enlightening for me to see what parents think about our school, what we are doing well, and what we can improve. If you would like to fill out the survey, you still can! In these newsletters, I am addressing the part of the survey that discussed our mission as a school. The question in the survey was "What parts of the ZLS mission are you happiest with?"

The answer options were:

- Eternal Life is the end goal for each of our students
- We teach Lutheran Doctrine
- Daily Devotions and Weekly Chapel
- We teach virtuous living
- We believe church attendance is necessary in educating your children
- We teach a biblical view of marriage and the family
- We reject that the primary purpose of education is to get a good job or go to college

In this newsletter, I will be focusing on the second answer options: We Teach Lutheran Doctrine. Four of the 12 parents that responded said that they were happy with this part of the ZLS mission statement. My goal is for all parents to understand why this is our mission and hopefully convince all that these are worthwhile missions of Zion Lutheran School.

Why Teach Lutheran Doctrine? An examination of the Lord's Supper

Zion Lutheran School teaches Lutheran doctrine because we believe that the Lutheran Confessions rightly interpret the Bible. We take the Bible's teachings very seriously because God has revealed Himself and our salvation clearly in the Bible. To understand further why this matters, let's look at a specific doctrine: The Lord's Supper.

The doctrine of the Lord's Supper is one doctrine that Lutherans agree with most Christians throughout the past 2,000 years, but understand differently than many American Christians. We believe that the bread and wine in the Lord's Supper become the actual Body and Blood of Christ as a Pastor recites Christ's words over them. Jesus teaches this in Matthew 28 and John 6, and the Apostle Paul teaches it in 1 Corinthians 11. All Christians for 1500 years understood Jesus literally in Matthew 28, which says:

And as they were eating, Jesus took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, "Take, eat; this is My body."

Then He took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave it to them, saying, "Drink from it, all of you. For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins..." (Matthew 28:26-28 NKJV).

Jesus teaches that the bread and wine in the Lord's supper are His Body and Blood. We hear from Jesus in John 6 eating his Body and Blood benefit us:

Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him (John 6:54-56 NKJV).

Because this teaching of the Lord's Supper is clear in the Bible, confirmed by early Christians, and important to the Christian life, we enjoy the benefits of the Lord's Supper and pass on this teaching to our children and students. Thanks be to God for this great gift!
